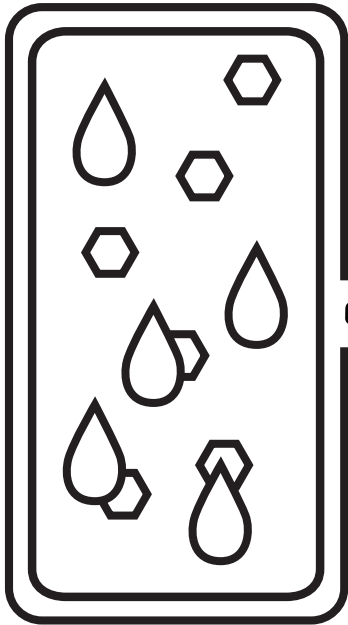




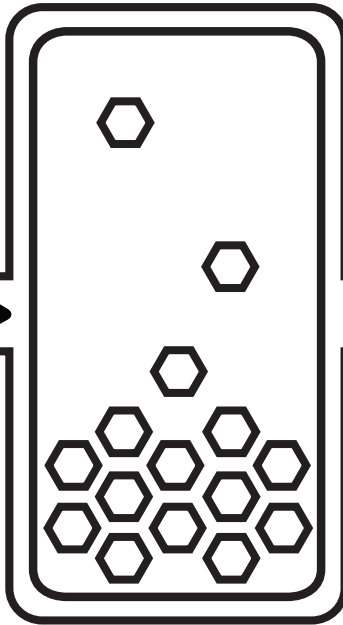
the WATER TREATMENT PROCESS

Coagulation



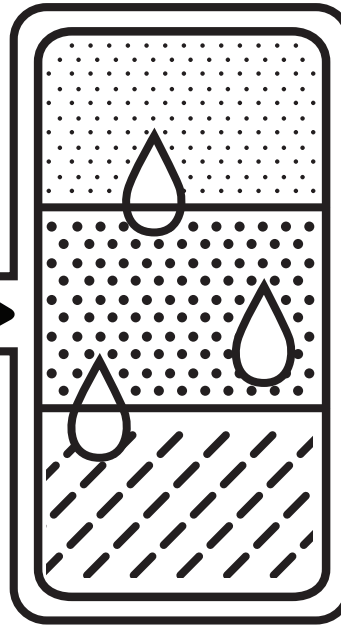
Bonding agents are added to form tiny sticky particles called "floc" which attract the dirt in the water.

Sedimentation



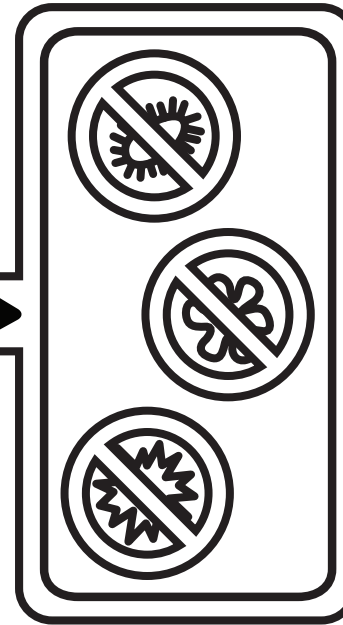
The heavy floc particles settle to the bottom and the clear water moves to filtration.

Filtration



The water passes through layers of sand, gravel, and charcoal to help remove even smaller particles.

Disinfection



A small amount of disinfectant is added to kill any bacteria or microorganisms that may be in the water.
