

HEDGE LANE PIPELINE, PUMP STATION & RESERVOIR

Expected Completion: Spring 2016



PROJECT UPDATE

WaterOne's largest distribution project to date is nearing completion. Located near Hedge Lane & 159th Street in the rural countryside, the Hedge Lane Pump Station will help improve water pressure in WaterOne's southern service area.

Construction on this \$65 million dollar project began in Spring 2014, and consists of over 13 miles of buried pipeline south along Highway 7 and Hedge Lane, and east along 175th Street to Ridgeview Road. The new pump station at Hedge Lane and 159th Street includes a 7.5 million gallon buried reservoir which will keep an ample supply of water on-demand, ensuring safety and supply well into the future.

FAQs

- **Is my water service provider changing?**
No, this project has no impact on which water utility services your home or business.
- **Will I see big pressure changes?** You may not even notice a difference in pressure, but in case you do we want to assure you that it is a planned adjustment. The effects will differ depending on factors like your location, elevation, and internal plumbing.
- **Will I be without water during the project?** We don't anticipate taking your water out of service, but in case that's necessary we will notify affected households through [NotifyJoCo](#).
